Community Haven with grant for Preschool

Manatee Community Foundation – through the Evans Family Charitable Fund, awarded Community Haven with \$5,000 last night to buy Selby Pre-School children new car seats and help with transportation costs. Selby Preschool is an inclusionary and early intervention and school readiness program for infants, toddlers and children up to age five who have a development delay or established medical condition that causes delays. Selby is the only preschool offering services for infants with disabilities and no other agency in the area offers the Montessori educational approach for children with disabilities. This grant will replace expired car seats for these children.
